

DNR – Do Not Resuscitate

If you don't want any cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) because of preconditions that make prolonging life with extraordinary means unwanted, how can you ensure these wishes will be honoured by the paramedics attending with an ambulance or when at the hospital?
